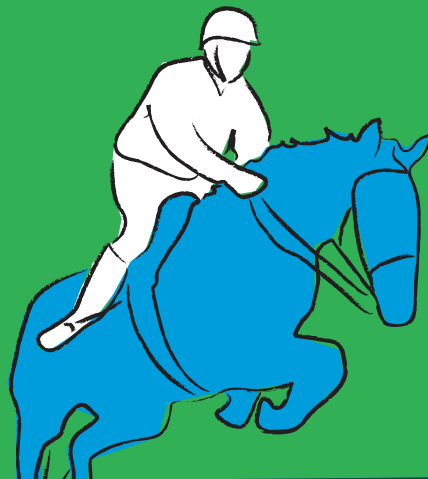
Secondary School
